Amino's beacons and tags do not collect personal data

As leaders in transparency, Amino Payments supports the European Union's decision to enhance the protection of personal data for EU citizens by increasing obligations for organizations that collect or process personal data.

AMINO DOES NOT:

- ▶ Identify individual end users of its members' websites
- ▶ Collect personal data from end users of its members' websites
- ▶ Track end users of its members' websites in any way (such as using cookies, fingerprinting techniques, or recording HTTP referrers)

These are the log fields Amino typically records for each request a client browser makes to our servers when an end user visits one of our members' websites, and the steps Amino takes to ensure that it does not collect personal data:

Log field	Is this personal data?
Date & Time	No
Method	No
Path	No
Protocol	No
HTTP Status Code	No
bytesSent	No
Serve Time	No
Client IP Address	No - Amino anonymizes the address by turning the last set of digits to all zeros.
User Agent	No - Amino completely blanks this field out.
Referrer	No - Amino completely blanks this field out.
